	distracted.
	Any class attendance questions need to be discussed with baptism class director.
	Ss. Cyril & Methodius baptism classes are good for 2 years after the date attended. If you need
	to baptize your child or be a Godparent after the two years, you will be required to take the classes
	again.
	If you have taken the classes within the last two years at another parish (and a certificate is provided), you are still required to attend SSCM class No. 2 (held on the fourth Wednesday of the
	month).
	A state issued vital statistics birth certificate is required to register your child for class attendance. $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ hospital issued certificate WILL NOT be accepted. In cases where there is guardianship/legal
	custody, or a single parent household, additional information may be needed in order to attend
	the classes.
	Parents need to register for the baptismal class at the parish office no later than 1 week before the
	start of the baptism class.
	There is a \$10.00 fee for the baptism preparation class per child; this fee is paid when you register for
	the class.
	Parents should be practicing Catholics who are presently registered at Ss. Cyril & Methodius
	Parish, and who are regularly participating in the Mass and the sacramental life of the Church.
